Origin

Most species of lavender are thought to come from the Middle East, the Mediterranean, and India.

Cultivation

Lavender favors a Mediterranean climate (dry summer climate) and does well with a lot of soil drainage. It does not do well in constantly damp soil and prefers a neutral soil pH..

Physical Properties

The lavender plant grows as a shrub with fragrant purple flowers of varying shades. It can grow to be as high as 6.5 ft tall. The flowers grow at the end of long evergreen spikes
