Equinox Magic

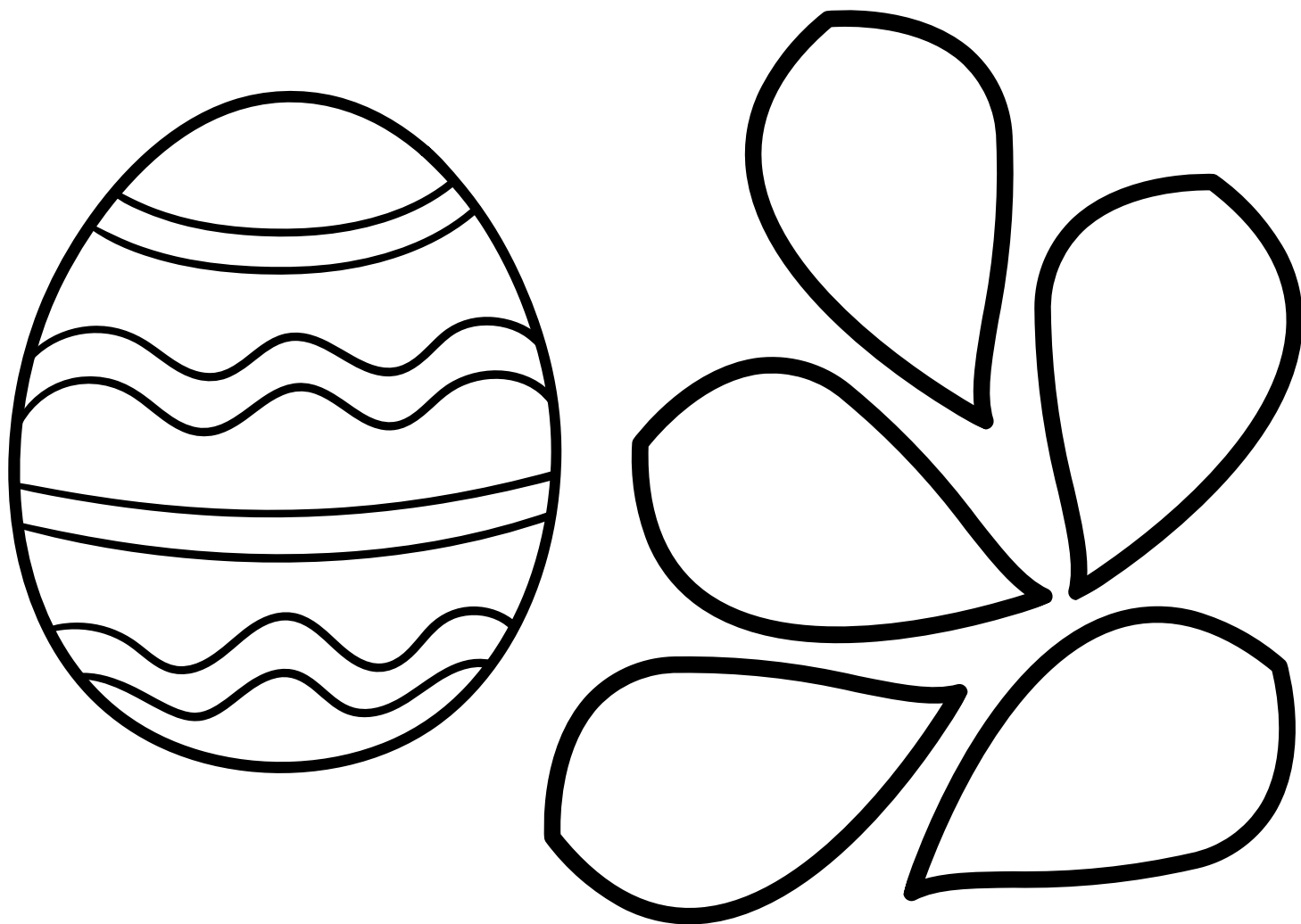
Witches around the world will be practicing magic and holding rituals during the Spring Equinox. Here are a few ways you can participate!
